Two-Way Bilingual (Dual) Immersion at Middle School

This in-depth, 3-day, TWBI Middle School Institute will address the purpose, philosophy and key features of a TWBI program at the Middle School. The Institute will assist administrators, teachers, and coordinators/facilitators as they continue the TWBI program into the secondary level. The structure of the Institute will begin with a visit to the Middle School TWBI program at River Glen Language Academy in San José USD on November 9. Additional topics to be covered on the following days of the Institute will include:

- Materials selection
- Articulation from the elementary level to the secondary level
- Articulation from middle school to high school
- Teaching strategies specific to a TWBI Middle School program
- Marketing & public relations
- Assessment & evaluation
- Strategies to motivate Middle School students

Time will be structured for team planning in order to develop a quality TWBI program at the secondary level for individual contexts. Bring your questions and expertise to share with fellow participants.

Participants will each receive a copy of the *2-Way CAFE TWBI Tool Kit – Grades 6-12*, a resource that will guide in the planning, implementation and monitoring of a Secondary TWBI program.
