Planning, Implementing and Monitoring Your Two-Way Bilingual (Dual) Immersion Program

This 3-day institute will address the purpose, philosophy and key features of two-way bilingual (dual) immersion (TWBI) programs. Participants are encouraged to attend as part of a team in order to take advantage of the resources and planning time allotted throughout the Institute. Team members may include: school board members, administrators, teachers, coordinators/facilitators and other interested educators.

The Institute will provide assistance for those teams who are planning for or are in the first year of implementation of a new TWBI program. In addition, the Institute will provide assistance for experienced TWBI programs as they critique their program according to the research-based "Guiding Principles for Dual Language Education."

- Curriculum & Instruction
- Assessment & Evaluation
- Staffing & Professional Development
- Program Structure
- Family & Community
- Support & Resources

Institute participants will receive the *2-Way C.A.B.E. TWBI Tool Kit*, a binder of resources that will guide them in the planning, daily implementation and monitoring of a TWBI program. In addition, opportunities will be available to participate in a TWBI school visit (see optional date information) and to peruse exhibits specializing in materials for TWBI programs.

Helen has been a TWBI teacher and program coordinator. She currently provides professional development and technical assistance for TWBI programs throughout San Bernardino County. She also co-facilitates the Inland Empire TWBI Network.

Aide Villalobos is currently an English Language Learner Specialist for Banning High School. She has seven years experience as an outstanding elementary TWBI teacher at both primary and upper grades. 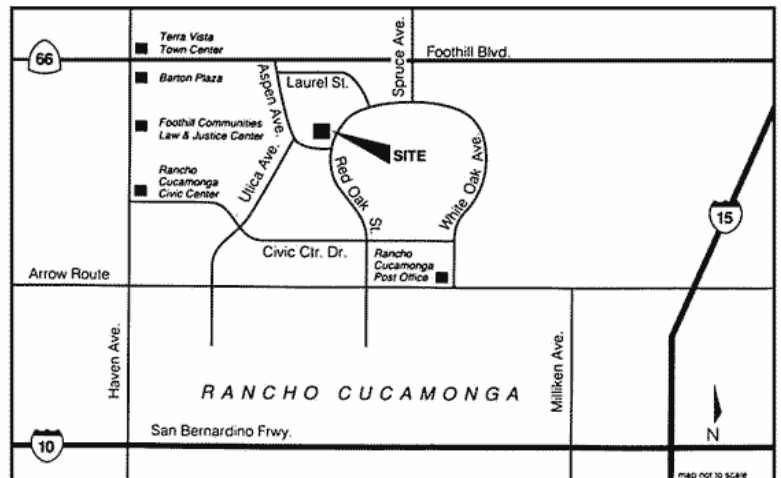
